

Community Ambassador Co-Ordinator Role

Role overview:

This role focuses on building strong local partnerships by recruiting community-based agencies and organisations to become Crimestoppers Community Ambassadors.

Role purpose:

To strengthen Crimestoppers' presence by expanding the local network of Community Ambassadors and developing relationships with community organisations.

Key responsibilities:

- Identify and contact potential Ambassadors.
- Recruit Ambassadors and deliver basic training on Crimestoppers' aims and activity.
- Provide Ambassadors with resources such as posters and leaflets.
- Maintain positive relationships and support Ambassador engagement within local communities.

Skills and qualities:

- Confident in speaking with senior representatives of partner organisations.
- Strong presentation, communication, and networking skills.
- Organised, community focused, and able to manage research and outreach activity.
- Previous volunteering or outreach experience is helpful but not essential
- Good organisational and research skills.
- Strong existing local connections.

Commitment:

Time commitment varies month to month and may include

- Local Committee meetings

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- Occasional national meetings
- Planning activities
- Partnership engagement

Training and support:

You will receive comprehensive training, plus ongoing support and guidance from your local team and the Volunteer Management Team.
