

Volunteer Force Crimestoppers Coach Role

Role Purpose:

The role of the Force Crimestoppers Coach volunteer is to attend Lincolnshire Police Headquarters and Stations on required input days, to showcase and present information about Crimestoppers, how the service works and how the force can make the best use of our resources available to them.

The role will empower Force officers and staff to contemplate Crimestoppers in each aspect of their role and ensure the service is considered to help and support their investigations, as well as close the loop on the process around the information received in to Force and the completion of feedback back into Crimestoppers to demonstrate the quality of information being received from the community.

Role:

- Attending officers and staff input and professional development days.
- Delivering presentations to Force officers and staff about Crimestoppers.
- Showcase the resources available to the force.
- Highlight the benefit of Crimestoppers information and the requirement to complete feedback on each piece of intelligence actioned.
- Link any Police Officer or staff in with the Regional Manager for continued work..
- Explore and develop partnership working with other external agencies



Experience:

- Previous volunteering experience.
- Presenting.
- Public speaking.
- Knowledge and understanding of Crimestoppers or the willingness to learn about how the service works.

Commitment:

- If required, agree to a DBS Check.
- Proactive and reliable.
- Ability to work as a team member to ensure successful delivery of presentations and introducing connections.
- Regular meetings with the Regional Manager.
- Commit to the principles of the Crimestoppers Volunteer Charter.
- Sign a Volunteer Agreement and Non-Disclosure Agreement.
- To dedicate the time to train and attend each requested input / training day.

Support:

The role will be supported through regular contact with the Volunteer Manager, Regional Manager, Chair and Force SPOC and reasonable out of pocket expenses, to fulfil essential activities, will be reimbursed.
