### Volunteer Community Coordinator Ambassador (Isle of Man)

Our volunteers connect people everywhere with the belief they can stop crime. Volunteers usually work as part of a local team, in a role that suits your skills and/ or experiences.

Crimestoppers is an independent charity that collaborates with the police, government, and voluntary organisations to raise awareness of crime and promote a service enabling anonymous crime reporting via telephone and online platforms. The Crimestoppers IOM Committee seeks a volunteer to join their efforts in safeguarding the Isle of Man community.

The position of Community Ambassador Coordinator is a newly established role for the Isle of Man. The primary objective of this position is to engage with various organisations on the Island, encouraging them to participate in raising awareness about the charity and promoting its mission.

#### **Commitment Requirements:**

This is a voluntary role. The Community Ambassador Coordinator should be available to meet with potential Ambassadors during working hours. The level of commitment required for this role can be discussed with the Committee, but it is expected to be approximately 6-8 hours per month. The Community Ambassador Coordinator will also attend IOM Committee meetings, typically held quarterly and lasting about an hour.

#### **Role Purpose:**

The Community Ambassador Coordinator manages the recruitment and retention of Community Ambassadors ('Ambassadors'). This role encompasses recruiting, training, motivating, encouraging, and supporting Ambassadors to ensure they achieve effective results and maximize the reach of the Crimestoppers message within communities.

**Role:**

- Collaborate with the Committee to identify and engage potential Ambassadors in the Isle of Man.
- Recruit Ambassadors by providing an overview of Crimestoppers' objectives and activities.
- Ensure Ambassadors have adequate resources (e.g., posters, leaflets).
- Maintain positive engagement with Ambassadors.
- Promote high levels of community involvement.
- Assist in organising any Ambassador events.

**Experience:**

- Proficient in communicating with senior representatives of organisations.
- Capable of delivering impactful verbal and written presentations.
- Strong interpersonal and networking skills.
- Excellent organisational and research abilities.
- Able to dedicate sufficient time to ensure the success of the role.

**Competences:**

- Facilitating and sustaining positive communications locally.
- Encouraging and fostering local partnership collaborations.
- Demonstrating interpersonal awareness and relationship management.
- Commitment to the policies, procedures, goals, and values of the charity.

**Commitment:**

- Attendance at committee meetings.
- Ability to travel to meetings, events, and networking opportunities.
- Adherence to the principles of the Crimestoppers Volunteer Charter.
- Signing of a Volunteer Agreement and Non-Disclosure Agreement.

- Regular contact with the Isle of Man committee and support from the Committee Chairperson.
